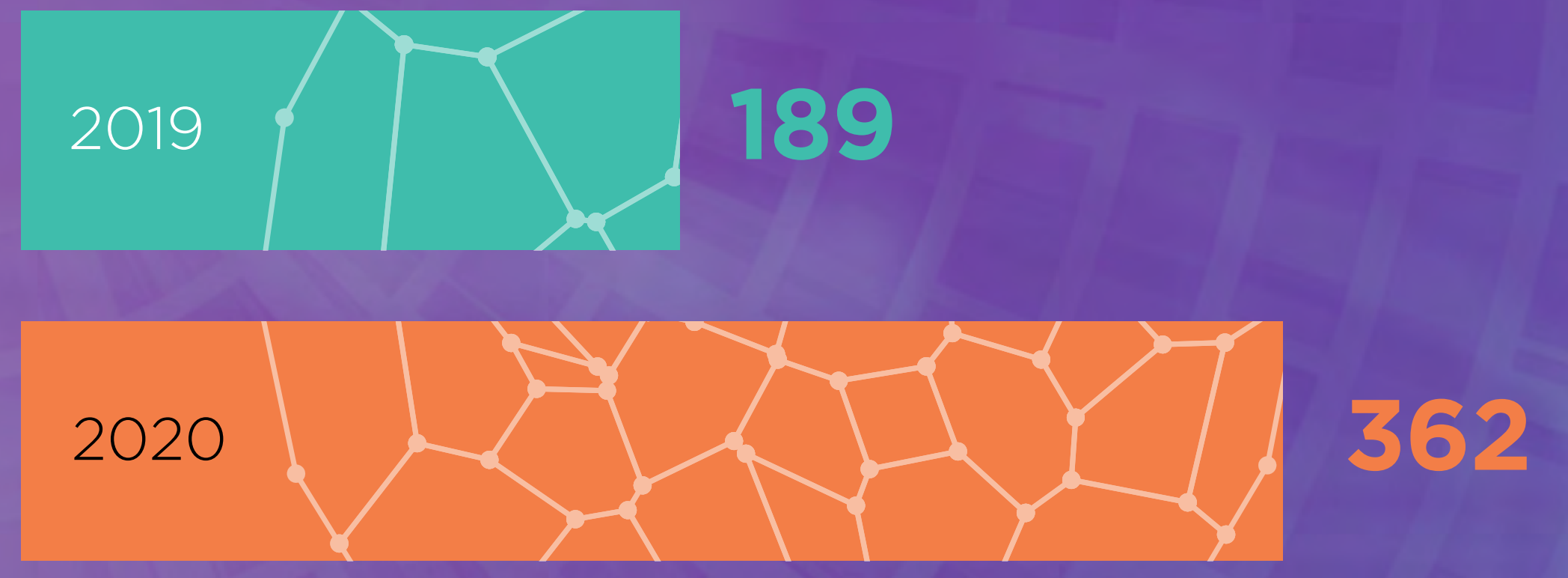

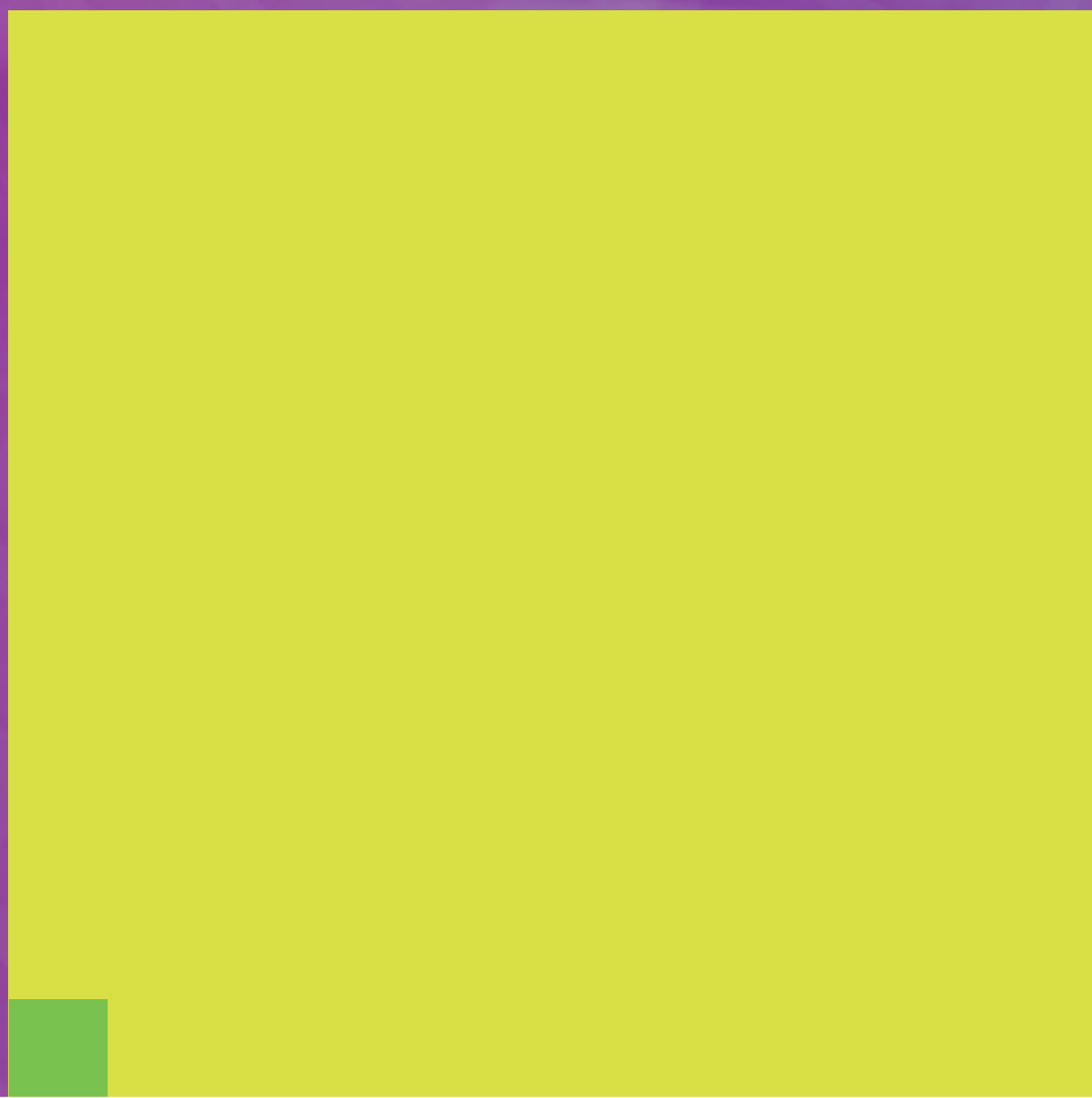

New CVEs assigned during 2020

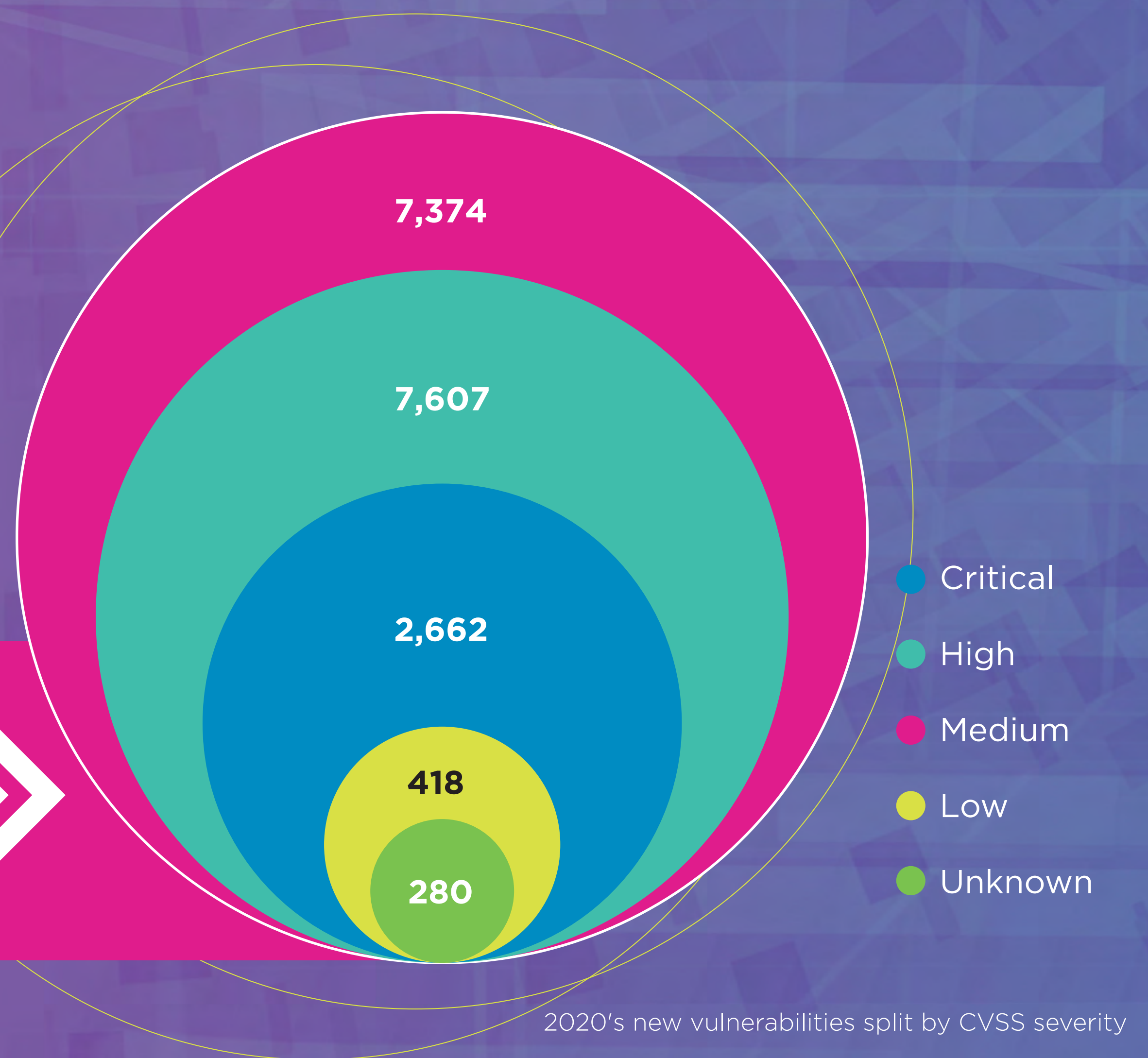
There are too many vulnerabilities to manage

Medium severity doesn't equate to medium risk

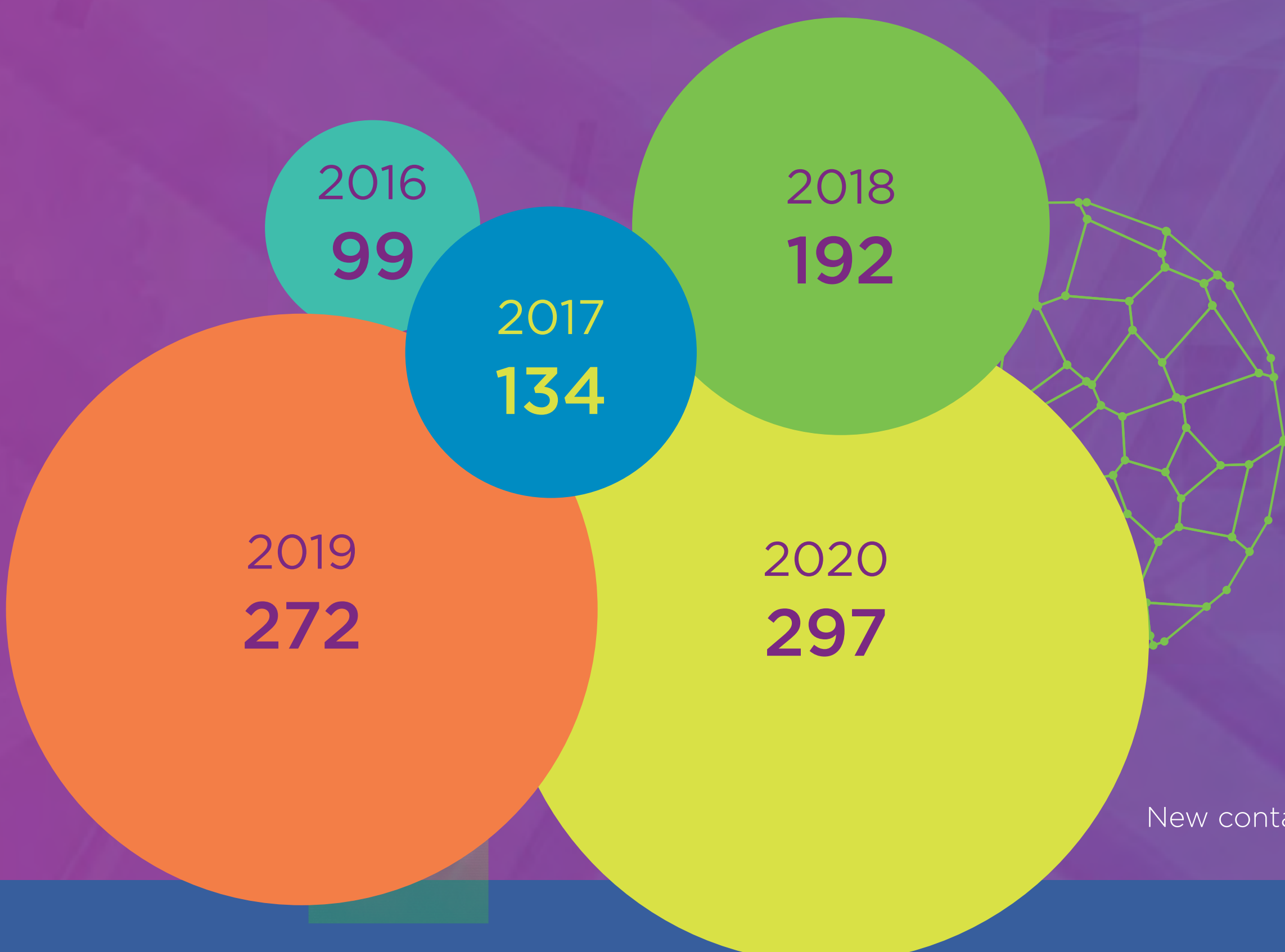


2020's new vulnerabilities split by CVSS severity

OT networks are under greater threat

Vulnerabilities within IIoT devices - which have notoriously poor levels of security -

increased **308%** over 2020
